Competition announcement for the conferment by appraisal of the qualifications of a scholarship for a graduate position in the Department of humanities and cultural heritage - University of Udine, entitled "Construction of a database of soldiers sentenced to death during the First World War on the military justice fonds of the Central State Archive (Rome)" – Head of research: Prof. Andrea Zannini

Art. 1 - Description

Research programme	<p>Title of Scholarship</p> <p>Construction of a database of soldiers sentenced to death during the First World War on the military justice fonds of the Central State Archive (Rome).</p> <p>Brief description of the activities entailed</p> <p>With Regional Law no. 7 of 28 May 2021, the Regione Autonoma of Friuli Venezia Giulia ordered the creation of a 'register' of military personnel, born or who died in the territory of the current Friuli Venezia Giulia Region, belonging to the Italian Armed Forces, who had been sentenced to death or had died by summary execution and 'decimation'. To this end, it appointed a 'Consulta sulle fucilazioni e decimazioni per l'esempio' (Consultation on Execution and Decimation by Example), which identified the archival fonds from which the names of interest could be obtained, and started a research project on war tribunals at the Central State Archives in Rome. The objective of the research grant is the finding, transcription, photographic reproduction and insertion into the already prepared database of all the documentation available in the archival series of war tribunals kept at the Central State Archive in Rome of cases of death sentences and summary executions and 'decimation'. In all the steps of these operations, the scholarship holder will have to work in close contact with the aforementioned Consulta, with working autonomy and in a collaborative and proactive manner.</p>

The conferment of this scholarship is aimed at the sole academic advancement of the recipient, it does not constitute an employment contract, and it does not grant access to a position in this institution.

Art. 2 – Degrees

The details of the competition hereby announced and the requirements for the candidates are specified in art. 1. The lack of a valid undergraduate qualification constitutes grounds for the immediate exclusion from the selection.

Candidates who hold an undergraduate qualification obtained from a foreign institution, not yet recognised under the provisions of the current legislation, must include in their application:
a) a copy of the degree complete with a list of the individual examinations undertaken and relative grades;

b) any other documentation useful to the appraisal of the candidate's qualification (Supplementary Diploma, etc.).

The candidate will have to enclose a signed translation of the documents in either Italian or English, in the event that the said documents are not already in Italian or English. To the purpose of this selection, the judging committee will verify the equivalence of the degree obtained abroad.

Art. 3 – Incompatibility



The scholarship connected to this competition cannot be awarded to anyone who is related, or related through marriage, up to the fourth degree of kinship, to:

Art. 4 – Application form

The application form, compiled on regular paper according to the model included below (Attachment A) and complete with the required documentation, must be mailed to Servizio Supporto alla Ricerca - Dipartimento di Studi umanistici e del patrimonio culturale – Vicolo Florio 2/B – 33100 Udine, and be received not later than the deadline for this selection notice. Late submissions will not be considered.

The application form must either:

- 1) be delivered in person to the Ufficio Protocollo of the University of Udine, Palazzo Florio – Via Palladio, 8 - 33100 Udine (which will proceed to its filing), at the following hours: Monday to Friday 9.00-11.30;
- 2) be sent via registered mail (raccomandata con avviso di ritorno) to: Università di Udine - Servizio Supporto alla Ricerca del Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici e del Patrimonio Culturale – via Palladio 8 – 33100 Udine, Italy; only applications received within the time limit indicated above will be accepted. Neither the date of dispatch nor the stamp date of the accepting Post Office will be taken into account;
- 3) be sent via certified email (PEC) to the address amce@postacert.uniud.it not later than the deadline indicated above. The candidate who sends the application form via PEC will not need to dispatch a hard copy of the form. The application and its attachments will have to be formatted as to avoid alterations to the text when accessed and stored (PDF/A and Adobe PDF). Application forms sent from an address other than Certified email, or failing to meet the other requirements specified in this paragraph, will not be considered valid.

The maximum size for applications submitted via PEC is 20 MB.

The administrative personnel decline any responsibility in the event that the files submitted through PEC are not readable.

The envelope must report details of the name, family name and address of the candidate as well as the following caption: "Selezione borsa di ricerca – Responsabile scientifico Prof. Andrea Zanini".

In the text of the application, as by D.P.R. 445/2000, the candidate will have to state clearly and precisely:

1. His personal details, date and place of birth, nationality, billing address and the preferred address for receiving communications about the selection procedure (taking care to specify the post code and, if possible, a current telephone number and email address);



2. That he/she meets the requirements specified in art. 1 of the present announcement;
3. That none of the conditions for incompatibility specified in art. 3 of this announcement and art. 9 of the Internal Regulation apply to his/her case.
4. That he/she commits to promptly inform the Department office of any change of his personal address.

The application must include the following attachments:

1. An academic and professional CV, signed and dated, where the candidate also expounds on the skills and aptitudes that are relevant to his/her work on the research programme, as described in art. 1;
2. A photostatic copy of his/her EEA ID or other valid identity document;
3. Attachment B related to the degree, and, only if obtained abroad, a copy of the degree complete with a list of the individual examinations undertaken and relative grades, and any other documentation useful to the appraisal of the candidate's qualification (Supplementary Diploma, etc.). The candidate will also have to enclose a signed translation of the documents in either Italian or English.
4. Attachment D - disclosure pursuant to article 13 GDPR, completed, dated and signed.

Applications without the aforementioned mandatory attachments will not be considered.

Other documentation that may be attached includes: Publications, certificates of merit and any other qualifications deemed useful to demonstrate the competence of the candidate in relation to the said programme.

Academic and professional qualifications are self-certified (attachment B). The other documents, including publications, may be either produced as originals, or photocopied and must include in this case a written *affidavit*, under the provisions of Rectoral Decree No. 421 del 08.05.2024 (attachment C);

Certificates issued by the Public Administration and by providers of public services cannot be taken into consideration. Certificates are substituted with self-certifications or written *affidavit*, under the provisions of D.P.R. No. 445 28/12/2000.

The administration reserves its right to conduct random checks into the genuineness of the self-certifications.

If the declaration should be found to be unfaithful, the declarer would be divested from the position obtained on the basis of the unfaithful declaration, in addition to the normal legal consequences of the act.

The Administration will not assume responsibility for the loss of any documentation caused by inaccuracies in the contact details provided, or late amendment of said details, nor for errors on the part of the postal services and not imputable to the Administration.

The candidates will be able to collect the personal documents and publications enclosed to their application forms after 180 days of the Directorial Decree notifying the winner and within the ensuing 30 days. The items will be entrusted "brevi manu" to the candidate himself, or to a deputy who has been appointed in writing by the candidate to collect the items for him/her.



Art. 5 - Evaluation of applications

The selection tests are designed to measure the applicant's skills and experience with special reference to the programme's aims, as defined in art. 1. These will consist of:

- appraisal of the candidate's academic curriculum, and of the publications and titles brought to the committee's attention.
- an interview designed to examine in greater detail the skills that are relevant to the position.

For the purpose of this selection, the Examining board will make use of telematic tools for collegial work.

The interview with the candidates will take place telematically, both audio and video, on January 30th, 2025 at 09.30 am through the Microsoft Teams platform. It is the responsibility of each candidate to obtain a Teams account.

This selection notice has the value of notification for the purpose of convening the interview. On the date and time set by the committee for the discussion, the connection between the commissioners and the candidate(s) will be activated, who must show the same identification document attached to the application.

Any exclusion due to lack of eligibility requirements or non-compliance with deadlines will be communicated to the candidates at the address indicated on the application form, by the Judging Committee.

Art. 6 – Examining board

The Commission will establish the criteria and procedures for the evaluation of qualifications and interview, in accordance with Article 13 of the Internal Regulations "Postgraduate Research Fellowships."

The results of the qualifications assessment must be disclosed to applicants during the interview. The Commission has a total number of 100 points attributable to the qualifications and the interview, where foreseen.

At the end of the evaluation procedure, the Examining board shall formulate the general merit list based on the overall score of each candidate, and draw up the minutes of the whole competition procedure.

Candidates who have obtained the minimum overall score of 70/100 (seventy hundredths) for qualifications and interview will be considered eligible.



Art. 7 – Award of scholarship

The scholarship is conferred, according to the ranking order, with Directorial Decree, upon acceptance of the selected candidate, and will take effect from the date stated on the Decree.

The results will not be notified by post to the candidates.

If the winner of the competition does not declare his acceptance of the scholarship by the deadline stated in the Decree of conferment, he/she will lose the right to the scholarship.

The research activity cannot commence before the recipient formally accepts the scholarship and before the effective date established with Decree.

Art. 8 – Renounce

The scholarship holder may renounce to the scholarship with written notice to be sent to the Department's office with at least twenty days notice. The last payment will be commensurate with the period of activity performed.

Art. 9 – Final report

At the end of the research period, the scholarship holder must deliver to the Department's office a detailed report on the research activity carried out and the results achieved, accompanied by the scientific responsible opinion, which may request further interim reports, according to the needs of the research project.

Art. 10 - Data processing

The selection procedure referred to this competition announcement, as well as the subsequent and possible one concerning the improvement of the legal relationship between the University and the winner, constitutes "treatment" pursuant to art. 4 §.1 n. 1 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, General Data Protection Regulation.

According to the art. 13 of this legislation and to art. 13 of D.Lgs. 196/2003, the University of Udine is obliged to provide to the candidates participating in the selection, as "interested parties", information concerning the processing of personal data.

The publication will take place within three months from the acceptance of the grant and will cease after three years from its conclusion. Candidates are therefore invited to draw up their curriculum bearing in mind that - in the event of the granting of the scholarship - it will be fully published.

Art. 12 – Final dispositions
