Call for applications for a postgraduate research grant at the Department of Humanities and Cultural Heritage - University of Udine, entitled “Digital Curation and Research Data Management for the DIUM Prehistory and Protohistory Laboratory” – Head of research: Prof.ssa Elisabetta Borgna.

Art. 1 - Description

Research programme	Title of Scholarship Digital Curation and Research Data Management for the DIUM Prehistory and Protohistory Laboratory Brief description of the activities entailed The research fellowship aims to support the maintenance, updating, and further development of the digital archives of the Prehistory and Protohistory Laboratory of the University of Udine, as well as the integration of datasets generated through recent research projects and fieldwork conducted by the Laboratory. Particular emphasis will be placed on the projects <i>Aquileia before Aquileia</i> and <i>Archaeology in Achaea</i>. With regard to the Friuli Venezia Giulia (FVG) regional context, priority will be given to the expansion and enhancement of digital resources for the inventorying and mapping of Protohistoric archaeological heritage across the lower Friulian Plain, within a broader regional perspective. The project will integrate legacy data and archival materials preserved in the University of Udine Laboratory into a multidimensional database designed to update existing (and often incomplete) documentation tools while addressing research needs and, above all, supporting heritage enhancement, public dissemination of archaeological knowledge, and educational activities. As concerns archaeological research abroad, the main objective is the acquisition, review, and digitization of documentation from ongoing field investigations in preparation for the systematic scientific publication of the research results. The planned activities include: – Reorganization, maintenance, and updating of the Laboratory's digital archives and software infrastructure. – Development and enhancement of open-access databases (E-dvara by Infofactory) through the inventorying of Protohistoric archaeological sites and cultural heritage assets within the regional territory, together with the integration of spatial
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	datasets from the University of Udine Laboratory archives into a comprehensive georeferenced information system. - Development of a dedicated digital archive for the classification and documentation of Protohistoric pottery. - Development of a GIS project aimed at expanding digital cartographic tools through QGIS plugins and the publication of integrated web maps incorporating geographic metadata and Digital Elevation Models (DEMs). - Review of excavation documentation and its digitization within a shared online environment based on a Network Attached Storage (NAS) infrastructure. - Coordination and organization of the cataloguing and study of archaeological

The conferment of this scholarship is aimed at the sole academic advancement of the recipient, it does not constitute an employment contract, and it does not grant access to a position in this institution.

Any personal communications to candidates regarding this selection process will be sent exclusively to the email address provided during registration for the selection process.

Art. 2

The details of the competition hereby announced and the requirements for the candidates are specified in art. 1. The lack of a valid undergraduate qualification constitutes grounds for the immediate exclusion from the selection.

Candidates who hold an undergraduate qualification obtained from a foreign institution, not yet recognised under the provisions of the current legislation, must include in their application:

- a copy of the degree complete with a list of the individual examinations undertaken and relative grades;
- any other documentation useful to the appraisal of the candidate's qualification (Supplementary Diploma, etc.).

The candidate will have to enclose a signed translation of the documents in either Italian or English, in the event that the said documents are not already in Italian or English.

The Commission will evaluate foreign qualifications based on the documentation attached to the application form and may exclude candidates if the documentation submitted does not provide sufficient information for evaluation. Candidates are therefore invited to attach all documentation in their possession relating to their qualifications in order to provide the Commission with sufficient information to evaluate their position.

Candidates are admitted to the selection process on a provisional basis and may be excluded at any time by reasoned decision if they do not meet the requirements.

Art. 3

The scholarship connected to this competition cannot be awarded to anyone who is related, or related through marriage, up to the fourth degree of kinship, to:

Art. 4

The application form, compiled on regular paper according to the model included below (Attachment A) and complete with the required documentation, must be mailed to Servizio Supporto alla Ricerca - Dipartimento di Studi umanistici e del patrimonio culturale – Vicolo Florio 2/B – 33100 Udine, and be received not later than the deadline for this selection notice. Late submissions will not be considered.

The application form must either:

- 1) be delivered in person to the Ufficio Protocollo of the University of Udine, Palazzo Florio – Via Palladio, 8 - 33100 Udine (which will proceed to its filing), at the following hours: Monday to Friday 9.00-11.30;

Neither the date of dispatch nor the stamp date of the accepting Post Office will be taken into account;
- 3) be sent via certified email (PEC) to the address amce@postacert.uniud.it not later than the deadline indicated above. The candidate who sends the application form via PEC will not need to dispatch a hard copy of the form. The application and its attachments will have to be formatted as to avoid alterations to the text when accessed and stored (PDF/A and Adobe PDF). Application forms sent from an address other than Certified email, or failing to meet the other requirements specified in this paragraph, will not be considered valid.

The maximum size for applications submitted via PEC is 20 MB.

The administrative personnel decline any responsibility in the event that the files submitted through PEC are not readable

The envelope must report details of the name, family name and address of the candidate as well as the following caption: **“Selezione borsa di ricerca – Responsabile scientifico Prof.ssa Elisabetta Borgna”**

In the text of the application, as by D.P.R. 445/2000, the candidate will have to state clearly and precisely:

1. His personal details, date and place of birth, nationality, billing address and the preferred address for receiving communications about the selection procedure (taking care to specify the post code and, if possible, a current telephone number and email address);
2. That he/she meets the requirements specified in art. 1 of the present announcement;
3. That none of the conditions for incompatibility specified in art. 3 of this announcement and art. 9 of the Internal Regulation apply to his/her case.
4. That he/she commits to promptly inform the Department office of any change of his personal address.

The application must include the following attachments, under penalty of exclusion:

1. a dated and signed scientific CV highlighting the candidate's aptitudes for carrying out and completing the research grant program described in Article 1;
2. a copy of a valid identity document or other valid identification document. Citizens of non-European Union countries must attach a copy of their passport or, if they have one, a copy of their Italian identity document and valid residence permit; Limited to citizens of non-European Union countries residing or authorized to reside in Italy, a copy of their residence permit or authorization to reside in Italy;
3. Attachment B related to the degree, and, only if obtained abroad, a copy of the degree complete with a list of the individual examinations undertaken and relative grades, and any other documentation useful to the appraisal of the candidate's qualification (Supplementary Diploma, etc.). The candidate will also have to enclose a signed translation of the documents in either Italian or English.
4. Attachment D - disclosure pursuant to article 13 GDPR, completed, dated and signed.

Applications without the aforementioned mandatory attachments will not be considered.

Other documentation that may be attached includes: Publications, certificates of merit and any other qualifications deemed useful to demonstrate the competence of the candidate in relation to the said programme.

Academic and professional qualifications are self-certified (attachment B). The other documents, including publications, may be either produced as originals, or photocopied and must include in this case a written *affidavit*, under the provisions of Rectoral Decree No. 556 del 07/08/2025 (attachment C); Certificates issued by the Public Administration and by providers of public services cannot be taken into consideration. Certificates are substituted with self-certifications or written *affidavit*, under the provisions of D.P.R. No. 445 28/12/2000.

The administration reserves its right to conduct random checks into the genuineness of the self-certifications. If the declaration should be found to be unfaithful, the declarer would be divested from the position obtained on the basis of the unfaithful declaration, in addition to the normal legal consequences of the act.

The Administration will not assume responsibility for the loss of any documentation caused by inaccuracies in the contact details provided, or late amendment of said details, nor for errors on the part of the postal services and not imputable to the Administration.

Any exclusion from the selection process due to failure to meet the eligibility requirements, absence of the required documents, failure to sign the application form, or submission of the application in a manner other than that specified in this notice will be communicated to the interested parties exclusively by email to the address indicated in the application form.

The candidates will be able to collect the personal documents and publications enclosed to their application forms after 180 days of the Directorial Decree notifying the winner and within the ensuing 30 days. The items will be entrusted "brevi manu" to the candidate himself, or to a deputy who has been appointed

in writing by the candidate to collect the items for him/her.

Art. 5

The selection tests are designed to measure the applicant's skills and experience with special reference to the programme's aims, as defined in art. 1. These will consist of:

- appraisal of the candidate's academic curriculum, and of the publications and titles brought to the committee's attention.

Art. 6

The Examining board is so composed:

The Commission will establish the criteria and procedures for the evaluation of qualifications, in accordance with Article 13 of the Internal Regulations "Postgraduate Research Fellowships."

The Commission has a total number of 100 points attributable to the qualifications and the interview, where foreseen.

At the end of the evaluation procedure, the Examining board shall formulate the general merit list based on the overall score of each candidate, and draw up the minutes of the whole competition procedure.

Candidates who have obtained the minimum overall score of 70/100 (seventy hundredths) for qualifications will be considered eligible.

Art. 7

The scholarship is conferred, according to the ranking order, with Act of the competent authority, upon acceptance of the selected candidate, and will take effect from the date stated on the act itself.

The results will not be notified by post to the candidates.

Those who do not declare their acceptance of the research grant or do not report to the research facility within the deadline communicated by email to the address indicated by the candidate in the application will lose their right to the grant, except for reasons of health or force majeure that are duly documented and promptly reported.

In the event of non-acceptance of the research grant or failure to report to the facility within the specified time frame, the ranking list of eligible candidates will be reviewed in order of score.

If the recipient renounces the research grant after it has begun, the University will evaluate whether or not to review the ranking list.

The research activity cannot commence before the recipient formally accepts the scholarship and before the effective date established with Decree.

The research grant referred to in this call for applications is subject to the tax and social security treatment provided for by law in force at the time of payment of the amount.

The research grant will be paid in monthly installments in arrears.

The cost of accident and third-party liability insurance is borne by the grant holder, unless already covered by the University.

Art. 8

At the end of the research period, the scholarship holder must deliver to the Department's office a detailed report on the research activity carried out and the results achieved, accompanied by the scientific responsible opinion, which may request further interim reports, according to the needs of the research project.

Art. 9

The data collected as part of the procedure referred to in Article 6 are necessary for the proper management of the selection procedure, for the possible subsequent management of the research grant, and for purposes related to the management of the services provided by the University. The University of Udine is the Data Controller. At any time, the data subject may request access, rectification and, compatibly with the institutional purposes of the University, erasure and restriction of processing, or object to the processing of their data. They may always lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority. Art. 10

Following the acceptance of the scholarship, the winner will be asked for a declaration regarding the performance of any other duties or the ownership of offices in private law entities regulated or financed by the Public Administration. The statement given by the scholarship holder and his curriculum vitae will be published on the University website, in the section "Amministrazione Trasparente", available at the link: <https://www.uniud.it/it/ateneo-uniud/ateneo-uniud/amministrazione-trasparente/consulenti-e-collaboratori-prova>.

The publication will take place within three months from the acceptance of the grant and will cease after three years from its conclusion. Candidates are therefore invited to draw up their curriculum bearing in mind that - in the event of the granting of the scholarship - it will be fully published.

Art. 11 – Final dispositions

As for subjects not explicitly cited above, the present announcement is covered by the provisions of the current legislation and of the "Internal Regulation" of the University of Udine issued with Rectoral Decree No. 556 del 07.08.2025.

2) FURTHER INFORMATION (Article 13 §.2 GDPR)

a) Retention period

The determination of the retention period of your personal data follows the principle of necessity of such processing.

Your personal data will thus be retained for as long as it is necessary for the purposes outlined above.

b) Data subject's rights

By using the abovementioned addresses, the data subject can exercise the following rights (in addition to the right to data portability ex Article 20 GDPR, not applicable to the present disclosure):
